Education & Networking

Meetings are held on the second Thursday of each month at various times and provide opportunities for members to share ideas and discuss the issues that affect our industry on local and national levels. The current meeting structure includes brief discussion of upcoming events and other Council issues, followed by an educational program presented by a Council member or other industry professional. These programs often involve sharing information on business practices or new products. Members can benefit from these products, techniques, or ideas that have proven to work well for other members. Most meetings are held in the HBA Conference Room; however, there are a few site visits scheduled through the year. Some members have volunteered to have site visits at their facility or showroom to share with other members how they do business.

Do you have questions/concerns regarding building permits and procedures? The Remodelers Council can be your "inside connection" to the Regional Building Department (RBD)! A representative from RBD is scheduled to attend each meeting and will be open to discussion on issues that affect your business and remodeling. At each meeting, monthly reports are provided by representatives from RBD, the Better Business Bureau (BBB), HBA Board of Directors, and HBA Education Committee, keeping members informed of local issues affecting our industry and upcoming educational opportunities available to you.

CODE OF ETHICS

The responsibility of every member shall be to conduct business and relationship with customers in the highest professional standards, providing customers with a complete understanding of job specifications, contract and price. All workmanship will be a standard acceptable within the industry.
