2016 Parade of Homes Award Winners Announced Congratulations to the People's Choice and Industry Awards Recipients

COLORADO SPRINGS – August 26, 2016 – The Housing & Building Association of Colorado Springs (CSHBA) announced Thursday the winners of the People's Choice Awards and the Industry Awards of Excellence for the 62nd annual Parade of Homes. The recipients were honored at the Parade of Homes Awards Banquet, held at the Pinery at The Hill with more than 240 people in attendance. Peak FM's Goose was the emcee of the evening.
