## Winners of 2017 Parade of Homes Awards Announced

*The HBA presents the People's Choice and Industry Awards of Excellence*

COLORADO SPRINGS, CO – August 31, 2017 – The Housing & Building Association of Colorado Springs (HBA) announced Tuesday the winners of the People's Choice Awards and the Industry Awards of Excellence for the 63<sup>rd</sup> annual Parade of Homes.

The recipients were recognized by the HBA at the Parade of Homes Awards Banquet held at The Antlers in downtown Colorado Springs. NASH FM's Cutter was the emcee for the evening. The event was generously sponsored by Amnet, Moen, Perceptive Image Creations, Pikes Peak Regional Building Department and Stewart Title.

The 2017 Parade of Homes presented 24 homes by 19 builders in communities throughout the Pikes Peak Region, with prices ranging from \$330,000 to \$1,850,000.
